

# 50 Animal Limericks That Will Make You Laugh Out Loud

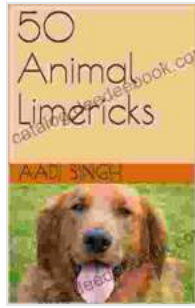

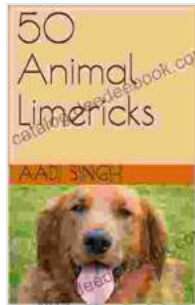
