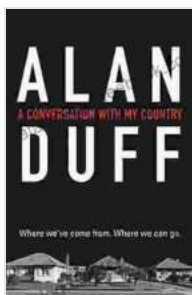


# A Conversation with My Country: Exploring Identity, Belonging, and the Search for Meaning

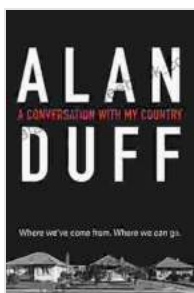
