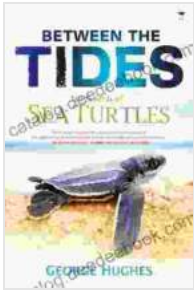


# Between the Tides: In Search of Sea Turtles

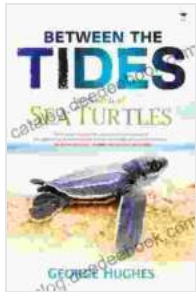
