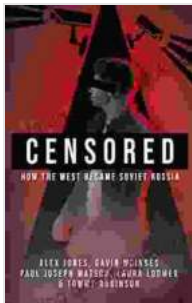


# Censored: How The West Became Soviet Russia

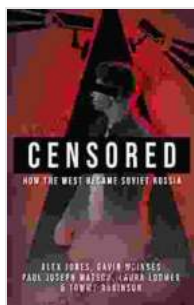
