

Rows 3-154

1. Ch 1, turn.
2. Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Row 155

1. Ch 1, turn.
2. Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next dc, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Rows 156-200

1. Ch 1, turn.
2. Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Row 201

1. Ch 1, turn.
2. Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next dc, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Rows 202-246

1. Ch 1, turn.

2. Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Row 247

1. Ch 1, turn.
2. Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next dc, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Rows 248-292

1. Ch 1, turn.
2. Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Row 293

1. Ch 1, turn.
2. Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next dc, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Rows 294-338

1. Ch 1, turn.
2. Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Row 339

1. Ch 1, turn.

- Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next dc, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Rows 340-384

- Ch 1, turn.
- Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Row 385


- Ch 1, turn.
- Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next dc, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.

Rows 386-430

- Ch 1, turn.
- Sc in the next 4 sc, *dc in the next ch 1 sp, ch 1, sc in the next 4 sc; repeat from * across.


