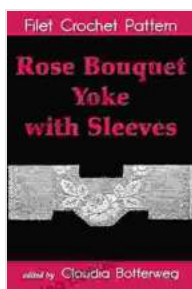

Row 3: Chain 2, *hdc in the next ch-1 space, chain 1, dc in the next dc, chain 1, hdc in the next ch-1 space, chain 1, skip 2 dc, dc in the next dc, skip 2 dc, chain 1, hdc in the next ch-1 space, chain 1, dc in the next dc, chain 1, hdc in the next ch-1 space, chain 1*. Repeat from * to * across. Turn.
5. Row 4: Chain 1, *hdc in each space across*. Turn.
6. Row 5: Chain 3, *skip 2 hdc, dc in the next hdc, skip 2 hdc, chain 1, hdc in the next ch-1 space*. Repeat from * to * across. Turn.
7. Repeat rows 2-6 until the yoke is the desired length.

Sleeves:

1. Chain a multiple of 10 plus 3.
2. Row 1: Sc in the second chain from the hook and in each chain across. Turn.
3. Row 2: Chain 3, *skip 2 sc, dc in the next sc, skip 2 sc, chain 1*. Repeat from * to * across. Turn.
4. Row 3: Chain 2, *hdc in the next ch-1 space, chain 1, dc in the next dc, chain 1, hdc in the next ch-1 space*. Repeat from * to * across. Turn.

5. Row 4: Chain 1, *hdc in each space across*. Turn.
6. Row 5: Chain 3, *skip 2 hdc, dc in the next hdc, skip 2 hdc, chain 1*. Repeat from * to * across. Turn.
7. Repeat rows 2-6 until the sleeves are the desired length.

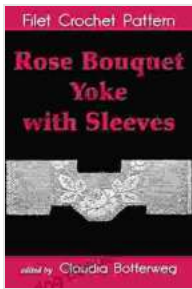
Assembly:
