Materials You'll Need:

- 1 sheet of 7-count plastic canvas
- Yarn in various colors (see pattern for specific colors)
- Plastic canvas needle
- Scissors
- Tacky glue
- Empty tissue box

Step 1: Creating the Base

1. Cut a piece of plastic canvas that is 10 inches wide and 10 inches high.
2. Starting in the center of one of the 10-inch sides, count 10 holes to the left and 10 holes to the right. These holes will form the top and bottom edges of the tissue box.
3. Starting at the leftmost hole on the top edge, single crochet (sc) across the entire width of the canvas, working into every hole.
4. Repeat step 3 for the bottom edge.

Step 2: Creating the Sides

1. Starting in the bottom left corner, sc up the side of the canvas, working into every hole.
2. Once you reach the top edge, turn the canvas and sc across the top, working into every hole.
3. Repeat steps 1-2 for the other three sides of the canvas.

Step 3: Adding the Trim

1. Cut a piece of yarn that is about 1 yard long.
2. Starting in the bottom left corner, sc around the outside of the tissue box cover, working into every hole.
3. When you reach the end of the yarn, tie off the ends securely.

Step 4: Creating the Animal Appliqué

1. Follow the pattern provided to create the animal appliqué of your choice.
2. Once the appliqué is complete, glue it to the front of the tissue box cover.

Step 5: Attaching the Cover to the Box

1. Apply a generous amount of tacky glue to the bottom edges of the tissue box cover.
2. Carefully place the tissue box cover over the empty tissue box, aligning the edges.
3. Press down firmly around the edges to ensure a secure bond.
